Display Charms Attach charms to a mesh vest (put charms through the holes) Attach charms to a felt sash (she closed the loop of the charm, then sewed them on like buttons) Attach charms to a hat (this was on a man - similar to hooks on a fishing hat!) Attach charms with no-sew glue onto just about anything! (Warning - they won't come off very easily, so make sure you want them attached!! You also can't read the backs if there is anything inscribed on them, but it looked neat!)
